

## Getting Started with AAU Diving

**It is easy to get started in AAU Diving. All the information and resources you need are online.**

### **AAU Club Membership**

Your first step is to join as an **AAU Club**. Club membership fees are \$30 (Level 1), \$60 (Level 2) or \$300 (Level 3). Club membership is valid from September 1 to August 31. On the right side of the web site, click on AAU Membership Programs and then Club Membership for information on the different club levels and the benefits of club membership. Once you have your AAU Club Code, you can use this code when registering the divers or give to the parents to use when registering their diver. You do not have to be part of club to participate in AAU Diving.

All club contacts will need to have a Non-Athlete Membership. With a valid Club Code and individual Non-Athlete Membership Number, you can access the **Club Admin Area**. ### **AAU Individual Membership**

To participate in AAU sanctioned events, all athletes and coaches must be members of the AAU. As a member, you can participate in any sport in the AAU. Individual membership is valid from September 1 to August 31. Youth athlete membership is \$12 per athlete. Non-athlete (coach, volunteer, official) membership is \$14. As a benefit of member, participants receive sport liability and accident insurance. [For complete information on insurance, please click here.](#)

### **Host an AAU Diving Meet or League**

As an AAU Club Level 2 or 3, you can apply to host you own meets or leagues. Meets can be hosted any time of the year. Sanction fees are \$50 per day or a maximum of \$350 for a league or series of meets. You must submit a Sanction Application online, including an event flyer. Once your event is approved, it will appear on the Find an Event online event calendar on the AAU web site. Just click on Event Sanctioning from the right side of the web page for more details.
