AGE DIVISIONS: June 1, 2009 shall be the determining date for the age of the competitor for all AAU Golf Events. Age divisions are as follows:

Boys and Girls age 16 & Under, 18 & Under.

ENTRY FEE: \$250 per athlete.

ENTRY DEADLINE: Completed entry forms, with entry fee, must be received by Monday, July 27, 2009. All entries must be paid via a credit card. All fees are non-refundable. Use web shop link. www.rtgolf.com/jga/proshop/shopdisplayproducts.asp?id=28&cat=AAU+18U+National+Championship
All credit cards will be processed August 1st, 2009.

AAU MEMBERSHIP: All participants must be members of their AAU District and must present their AAU Membership card at athlete check in. To purchase AAU Membership Cards, log on to www.aasports.org

RULES: Play will be governed under the USGA Rules of Golf. The AAU Golf Committee reserves the right to alter any of the conditions or schedules herein. The decisions of the AAU Golf Committee in any matter shall be final.

COMPETITION FORMAT: Competition will consist of 54 holes of stroke play for 16U and 18U divisions. Length of competition shall be adjusted at the discretion of the AAU Golf Committee due to weather or unforeseen conditions.

PRACTICE ROUND: The practice round will be a shotgun start at 1:00 pm on Sunday, August 2nd. The costs of the practice round and practice range balls are included in the event entry fee. Any additional practice rounds should be scheduled with the Oxmoor Valley Pro Shop and the cost of these additional rounds will be the responsibility of the individual athlete.

RULES MEETING: Sunday, August 2nd, at noon in the Oxmoor Valley Club House. This is a mandatory participant rules meeting! Parents are welcome to attend.

ATHLETE PARTY: The athlete's party will be held outside of the Oxmoor Valley Club House on Tuesday, August 4th, at 5:00 pm. If parents would like to eat at the athlete's party, they may purchase tickets at time of payment online.

AWARDS: AAU National Championship Trophies for Champion and runner-up and AAU National Medals will be awarded to athletes who place in the top six in each age division for boys and girls.

CHECK IN: Check in for all athletes will be held August 2, from 8:00 AM until noon at the Oxmoor Valley Club House, located at 100 Sun Belt Parkway, Birmingham, AL 35211.
