Awards: At the conclusion of each session all athletes will be awarded an AAU National Championship medal in the All-Around and 1/2 plus 1 for their individual events.

Opening Ceremonies: The Parade of Champions will be held on Thursday, July 1st, 2010 starting at 6:00 PM. Athletes will march onto the competition floor in the Milkhouse. Immediately following the march in will be a celebration for all athletes, coaches and families. An admission ticket from the box office for July 1, 2010 (at least) is required.

Hospitality Room: A coaches' hospitality room will be provided. Access to this room is off the main competition floor. Coaches must present their credential to gain admittance.

- This event is sanctioned by the Amateur Athletic Union of the U. S., Inc.
- All participants must have a current AAU membership.
- AAU membership may not be included as part of the entry fee to the event.
- AAU membership must be obtained before the competition begins except where the event operator has a laptop available with an internet connect. Participants are encouraged to visit the AAU web site www.aausports.org to obtain their membership

*****ONLINE REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS*****

The 2010 AAU Gymnastics Age Group National Championship will be using an online registration system ONLY! This is new to this event but extremely easy to use. Below are some instructions and helpful hints on how to register your team:

1. Fill out Intent to Participate online at www.aaugymnastics.org
2. To register your team(s) please visit www.aaugymnastics.org. Click on the Online registration link to get started!
3. **Step 1:** Log In/Register (Create an Account) – **The person registering the team must create a user name and password. This is not your AAU membership or club number.** A confirmation email to confirm your information and activate your account will be sent. You must activate your account before you can proceed. Once your account is activated you can begin to register your Gym and athletes.
4. **Step 2:** Enter Gym Information – Add your Gym information.
5. **Step 3:** Enter Athletes to Roster – Click on the Enter Athletes link. If you entered a valid 2010 AAU Club membership ID the athletes attached to your club will appear. Simply click those athletes that will be competing. If an athlete does not appear, you can add them to the Gym roster by entering their 2010 AAU Membership ID and zip code. **IMPORTANT: From the Gym Roster screen please make sure that you enter all your athlete's Level information! You cannot process your registration until this is complete!**
6. **Step 4:** Enter Coaches – Click on Enter Head Coach, Assistant Coaches link. **IMPORTANT:** You MUST have all coaches 2010 AAU Non Athlete Membership card prior to entering your coaches.
7. **Step 5:** Complete Remaining Forms – It is **MANDATORY** to enter Level Information for all your athletes. If you have not entered this information a Red Flag will appear on your roster next to the athlete who is missing this information. The system will not let you pay for your athletes until this step is completed.
8. **Step 6:** Check Out - This is where you pay your entry fee (\$75.00 per athlete or \$100 Men's Team Fee). Please use a debit or credit card ONLY (VISA, MasterCard, Discover, American Express). If you cannot pay with a credit card please contact Tony Staley, 407-94-7200 (Phone) or tony@ausports.org for further instructions. We will accept Check or Money Orders, but only if necessary (We know a lot of the gyms or YMCA organizations will only pay by check. We will accommodate this request) Once this process is completed, you will receive an email confirmation verifying your payment. We recommend printing and saving this email for your own records.
