
There will be an invitational competition held in conjunction with the Team Trials.

Sub-Advanced and Advanced Passes are now One 5-Skill Pass & One 8-Skill Pass

☎ TRAMPOLINE

Intermediate Compulsory Skills are a Front Somi (any position), Back Tuck, Front or Back Contact, and a Full Turn. Maximum or Five (5) Somis.

Sub-Advanced Compulsory Skills are a Back Straight, 3/4 Front or Back, Barani Tuck, and Two Optional Somis.

☎ DRESS CODE

Male Dress Code - Same as before EXCEPT must wear shorts on Tumbling & Double-Mini; may wear either shorts or pants on Trampoline.
