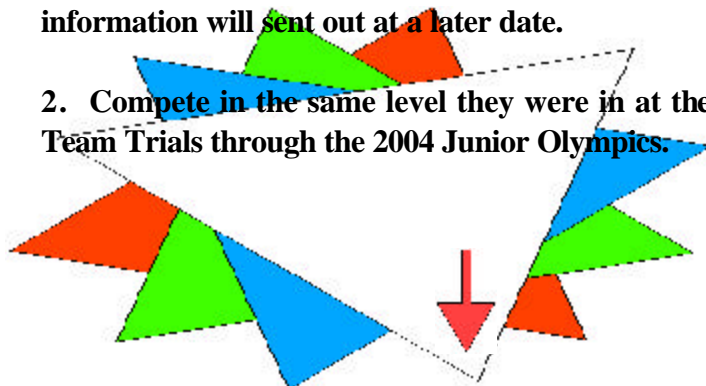
There will be an invitational competition held in conjunction with the Team Trials.

TUMBLING

Sub-Advanced and Advanced Passes are now
One 5-Skill Pass & One 8-Skill Pass

TRAMPOLINE

Intermediate Compulsory Skills are a Front
Somi (any position), Back Tuck, Front or Back
Contact, and a Full Turn. Maximum of Five
(5) Somis.

Sub-Advanced Compulsory Skills are a Back
Straight, 3/4 Front or Back, Barani Tuck, and
Two Optional Somis.

DRESS CODE

Male Dress Code - Same as before EXCEPT
must wear shorts on Tumbling & Double-Mini;
may wear either shorts or pants on Trampoline.
