Please make the following corrections to the rules.

Age Levels: Tumbling, Sub-Novice Boys'

Change: The oldest age group should be 13-20 yrs.

Duties of the Aesthetic Judge: Tumbling

Add: The word **control** with the evaluation of execution description.

Finals Competition @ National Championships:

Add: The starting order for the finals will be in order of merit, the competitor with the lowest preliminary score going first. The total combined scores from prelims and finals will be used to determine finals placement.

Add: Sub-Beginner Tumbling finals will consist of one pass.

Change: Tumbling Advanced Final's Warm-up to consist of two minutes per athlete.

Verbiage

Change: All references of State to Association throughout.

Dress All Events, Footwear - Men Only:

Change: Include Exception: colored foot covering may be worn provided they are the same color as their long team competition pants.

Positions of a Somersault Skill

Add: The position of a somersault is determined between 10 o'clock and 2 o'clock.

Profanity

Delete: Use of profanity or unsportsmanlike conduct during the competition will result in disqualification from the competition, for the first offense. (Correct procedures already defined under Conduct and Dress Code Deductions.

1st offense: 0.3 pt deduction and warning; 2nd offense: Brought to Executive Committee for consideration and action up to and including disqualification.

Difficulty, Tumbling - Reversal Front Somis

Change: Bonus is 0.1 pt, not 1.0 pt.

Trampoline, Novice pass requirements

Change: 2.2 to read. The six (6) optional skills may be selected from the list below and/or the beginner list.

Mandates, All Events

Add: Mandates to be effective by the next meet.

Difficulty, Double-Mini,

Tuck Front Somi *Change:* to 0.5 pts

Tuck Back Somi *Change:* to 0.5 pts

Guide to Judging Double-Mini Landing - Distance from center

Change: 0 to .0; 1 to 0.1; 2 to 0.2; and 3 to 0.3
