**Weigh-in, Registration/Time:** 7:30 am to 8:20 am. Wrestling begins at 9:00 am **Registration:** \$12 entrance fee for one event and \$15 for both events. Wrestlers are required to have an AAU card (Eagles Club members have one).

We are happy to offer the **4th Annual Takedown & Escape Tournament at Niceville, Florida!** All wrestlers, coaches and fans are invited to see who the best takedown & escape wrestlers are. We hope to see you here!

**Directions:** From the east: travel west on I-10 until you reach the Crestview exit and turn left on 85 South. From the west: travel east on I-10 until you reach the Crestview exit and turn right on 85 South. Stay south on 85 until you reach Hwy. 20 (aka John Sims Pkwy) Turn left at the traffic signal and go east to Partin Ave. Turn right at traffic signal on Partin for about 100 yards. The CLC gym location is on the right.

**Weight system** (weight classes determined after weigh-ins based on number of participants). Opponents determined by blind draw. Tournament will be either double elimination or round robin depending on number of entrants.

## Madison Weight System Divisions:

Pre-Elementary: Wrestlers not yet enrolled in school through Kindergarten. Elementary I: Wrestlers from 1st through 3rd grades. Elementary II: Wrestlers from 4th grade through 6th grade. Middle School: Wrestlers from 7th grade through 9th grade. High School: Wrestlers from 10th grade through 12th grade.

## Matches: CLC Modified NHSF rules will be followed:

**Takedowns:** One two minute period per match. Three takedowns by the same wrestler ends the match. If the Number of takedowns is tied at the end of the period, a one minute sudden death overtime will be held. If there is no takedown in the overtime period, the wrestler who scored the first takedown wins. Criteria Overtime: If there is no takedown in overtime the official will call stalling on the least aggressive wrestler at the end of the overtime period.

**Escapes:** Each wrestler will have a one minute period to escape. If a wrestler escapes before a minute the referee will reset the wrestlers until time has expired. An escape is awarded 1 point, a reversal 2 points and a reversal to a pin 3 points. If the score is tied at the end of the match the wrestler with the highest number of points wins. If the points are even, an additional two 15 second periods will be conducted until one wrestler is declared the winner by the referee. (All rules and regulations are subject to revision by tournament staff)

Uniforms: Singlet preferred but not required; alternate attire is shorts without pockets/zippers

and tucked in t-shirt. Headgear is recommended. Participants must wear wrestling shoes or socks.

Awards: Medals for top three places in each weight class for each event.

Concessions: Available on site.
