SUPER SAVER GAME RULES

- 1. 17-minute halves with a running clock. Clock stops for:
 - a. Timeouts.
 - b. All freethrow attempts.
 - c. Last two minutes of each half.
 - d. The clock will run in the 2nd half if there is a 25-pt lead.
- 2. Four timeouts per game (2 30's and 2 60's) ... they DO carry over to the second half.
- 3. Overtime:
 - a. 1st Overtime=2 minutes w/one 30-sec. TO for each team
 - b. 2nd Overtime= first team to three points ... no clock/notimeouts ... team fouls still in force from regulation.
- 4. Warm-up time and halftime is FOUR minutes.
- 5. Games will start on the hour ... warm up time and halftime will be determined by the game time.
- 6. Substitutes must report to the scorer and may not enter the game until motioned onto the court by an official.
- 7. Stats kept:
 - a. Team running score
 - b. Team fouls
 - c. Individual fouls
 - d. Timeouts
- 8. Late Teams & Forfeits:
 - a. If a team is late (up to 15 minutes), it is important that a game is played regardless. Halftime and pre-game will be cut to ONE minute (as well as in subsequent games if needed).
 - b. Actual playing time should not be cut if at all possible, but may be adjusted if needed.
 - c. The gym supervisor will make this decision after consulting coaches
- 9. Any coach or player ejected from a game will not be allowed to participate in the next game.
- 10. Coaches please do not run up the score on other team
- 11. Coaches: YOU are responsible to set a good example for your players and fans. If you or your players or your fans create an environment that is dangerous or threatening to others' safety, then the officials and/or the gym supervisor will call the game a forfeit in favor of your opponent. The game will not be replayed and the league supervisor will determine if you and your team will be allowed to continue participation in future Super Saver events. There will be no refund for games not played if the situation occurs.
