Age is determined by December 31 of the year of the competition.
All age group divers remain qualified from the 1st of January to midnight of the following 31st December in the year of competition.

Top 6 divers in each event qualify for the Red-White-Blue National Diving Championship. Should a top 6 diver decline to attend, the 7th place diver will be invited to attend and so on. Divers who qualify in a springboard event automatically qualify for the Red-White-Blue Platform event. Divers who ATTEND the Red-White-Blue National Diving Championships will be outfitted.
