Entry Fee:

Entry Fees: \$50.00 per event (Entry fees are NON-REFUNDABLE). On Time Entry deadline is *FRIDAY*, *MARCH 21st at 11:59 pm MST*.

Late Fee: \$25.00 will be assessed, on top of the registration fee, after the deadline.

Late Registration Deadline: TUESDAY, APRIL 1st at 11:59 pm MST **Deck Entry Late Fee (Day of Event):** \$50 + Event Registration Fee

There will be <u>no dive change fees</u>. However, once the deadline for changes has passed (3 hours before the start of the event), **absolutely NO DIVE CHANGES be made.**

Declaration of Intent (DOI): All divers competing in the QUALIFYING events, must fill out a DOI (Declaration of Intention to attend link will be provided later) the RWB Nationals on Memorial Day Weekend in Huntersville, NC, BEFORE the start of the meet!
