Diver/Coach entrance: Divers and coaches will enter the aquatic center on the bottom level through the outside door by the outdoor volleyball courts. There will be a sign. Parents will proceed up the outside steps and enter from the lobby upstairs. No parents are allowed on deck.

- AAU membership is not included as part of the entry fee to the event.
- AAU **Youth** Athlete membership must be obtained before the competition begins. **Be Prepared: Adult and Non-Athlete memberships are no longer instant and cannot be applied for at an event. Due to background screenings, please allow up to 10 days for membership to be processed.**
