**Late Fee: \$25.00 will be assessed, on top of the registration fee, after the deadline.**  
**Late Registration Deadline: Tuesday, March 25<sup>th</sup> at 5:00pm ET.**  
**Deck Entry Fee (Day of Event): \$50 per event.**  
**There will be no dive change fees. However, all changes must be submitted at least 1 hour prior to the start of the event.**
- DOI: All divers competing in the QUALIFYING events, must fill out a DOI (Declaration of Intention) for the RWB Nationals on Memorial Day Weekend in Huntersville, NC, BEFORE the start of the meet! - Practice Times:** **Friday, March 28:** 3-8pm - Open practice springboards only; 3-5pm platform event warm-ups only.  
**Saturday, March 29:** 7-8:15am - Open warm-ups for Saturday competitors.  
Evening open warm-ups until 6pm if meet finishes before then.  
**Sunday, March 30:** 7-8:15am Open warm-ups for Sunday competitors.

**Facility:** Two – 1 meter and 3 meter springboards on cement stands; One – 1 meter, 3 meter, 5 meter, 7 meter, and 10 meter platform. Pool depth: 18ft.

**Schedule:** The schedule can be found on DiveLive. The events will be held on the designated day, but the order of events will be decided after all entries are received.

**Deadlines' Calendar:** It is important that all divers competing in the 9 AAU RWB Qualifiers be treated the same. Rules and deadlines are the same regardless of the meet date. We understand that the official registration closing date is after the one stated on your “Deadlines’ Calendar” but these need to be respected. We appreciate your help!
