- *Will all events be offered?*
  - Unfortunately, no. The 2000m Steeplechase, Triple Jump, Turbo-Javelin, Javelin, High Jump, Pole Vault, Triathlon, Pentathlon, Heptathlon & Decathlon will not be offered this year.
