Coaches & Athlete check information can be found at the back of this packet. Only pre-registered coaches & athletes will receive credentials! Registration on-site is not guaranteedplease confirm your rosters via the district sheets. \*It is the head coach's responsibility to review the roster sent from the meet director to verify all their gymnasts and coaches are registered and their information is correct prior to arrival.

Credentials must be worn each day to enter the competition venue and obtain access onto the competition floor.

Outside Food/Drink (coolers, take-out, etc.) are prohibited. Coaches and athletes are allowed to bring a water bottle (NO glass).

Coaches will have a hospitality area on the competition floor with snacks and lunch daily. Food may not be taken outside of the curtained area.

AAU Junior Olympic Games LOC provides trainers onsite. Please locate their booth by the head table for any sports medicine needs (ice, bandaids, injuries, etc.)

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We will have coaches meetings twenty minutes before the competition each day.

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All athletes will compete all around in the preliminaries on Wednesday or Thursday.

**All Levels EXCEPT Open Optional:** The top six athletes on each event will move into the finals on the specified event Friday/Saturday. If there is a tie for the six place athlete, we will advance the tie.

**Open Optionals Only:** All athletes will advance to finals Saturday and scores will be carried over from day one for International Team placement only. Event finals placings will be based on clean start scoring.

All Levels EXCEPT Open Optional: Prelim awarded 50% + 1 fo events and 100% all around. Final event awards at 50% + 1, no all around.

**Open Optionals Only:** Prelims 50% + 1 for events, no all around. Finals 50% + 1 events and 100% all around.

Special Awards (All Americans and Joel Ferrell) will be given during our Parade of Champions Saturday morning.

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Our International Team will be named as the top 5 combined prelim and final scores from the AAU Junior Olympic Games in each of the following age groups:

Youth (12 and Under) Junior (13 and 14) Senior (15 and Over)

Ages are based off the FIG determination date of 12/31/2025.

Athletes will be provided at minimum a competition leotard and warm up each year qualified to the team.


#### ATHLETES & COACHES


#### **SPECTATORS**
