- ONLINE REGISTRATION & ENTRY DEADLINE:** **In addition to registering with USA Field Hockey, all athletes must register with AAU online at www.aaujrogames.org. Entries must be completed online by Thursday, July 11, 2024.** Visa, MasterCard, American Express or Discover is accepted.
- Step 1:** Become a member of AAU at www.aausports.org. Click on Join AAU and select Athlete Membership. Follow the registration steps online. Once you have your AAU membership number, proceed to Step 2. If you have a valid AAU membership for 2023 (for any sport), skip this step.
- Step 2:** Register for the event at www.aaujrogames.org. Click on Field Hockey and then click on Online Event Registration. Follow the steps online. After registering, you will receive an email confirming your entry and acceptance of payment.
- Step 3:** Register with USA Field Hockey. Visit www.usafieldhockey.com for information.

- AWARDS:** AAU Junior Olympic Games medals will be awarded to all members of the top three (3) girls team and top two (2) boys teams.

- ATHLETE CHECK-IN:** **Athletes must check-in before being allowed to practice or compete.** Field Hockey participants must check-in at the **Wake Forest University** – 211 Manchester Athletic Center, Winston-Salem, NC 27109 to receive their athlete credential or coach wristband. The appropriate credential or wristband will be needed prior to gaining admittance into the competition venues.
