Beginner: No more than 1 year
 Novice: 1 yr., less than 2 yrs.
 Intermediate: 2 yrs., less than 4 yrs.
 Advanced: 4 yrs. + (must wear BROWN belt in competition/brown division)
 must wear BROWN belt in competition/brown division)
 must wear BLACK belt in competition/black division)

Athletes will not be allowed to compete without appropriate belt color & official AAU karate patch sewn on Gi.

AGE GROUPS & EVENTS (Competition age is age as of JULY 1, 2022)

<u>YOUTH (Age 5 – Beginner only) (Age 6 – Beginner/Novice only) (Age 7 – Beginner/Novice/Intermediate only)</u> <u>YOUTH (Ages 8 - 17 years) - Beginner/Novice/Intermediate/Advanced</u>

Divisions: Kobudo (long & short divisions for advanced), Kata, Kumite (light & heavy)

13-14 & 15-17 Advanced may also compete in Ippon Kumite (Both will have light & heavy divisions)

Mandatory Kata (advanced athletes, 16 + yrs., may also compete in this additional event with the adult advanced (18-34 age group) in mandatory style Kata & Flag Kata

Ages: 5-6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 (Competition age is age as of July 1, 2022)

ADULT (Ages 18 - 34 years) Beginner/Novice/Intermediate

Divisions: Kobudo, Kata, & Kumite (light & heavy) Ages: 18 - 34 years (Competition age is age as of July 1, 2022)

ADULT ADVANCED ONLY (Ages 18 - 34 years)

Kata & Kobudo Divisions

Kobudo long/Kobudo short

Mandatory Kubudo: NEW DIVISION - There will be three rounds. (round 1 – short weapons/ round 2 – long weapons/ round three – open selection of weapons (must do a different form then ones performed in round 1 and 2)). Top sixteen competitors from Round 1, advance to Round 2. Top eight competitors from Round 2, advance to Round 3 (final round). In the event there is less than 17 competitors in the event, there will only be two rounds of competitions, one long weapons, one short weapons. May also compete in individual kobudo long and kobudo short. There will be one male & one female division for Mandatory Kobudo. Winner of this division will be the 2022 Kobudo Champion. Open to advanced competitors, ages 16 and up.

Mandatory Kata: All Style / Goju / Wado /Shito /Shorin /Isshin / Shotokan Athlete may participate in <u>one discipline only</u>. There will be three rounds. The category will be contested only if there are at least 16 athletes in that category. If not, those athletes will be placed in All Style category. May also compete in a separate flag kata division open to all adult advanced. There will be one male & one female division for each category of Mandatory Kata.

COLLEGIATE DIVISIONS

Open to competitors currently enrolled in post-secondary education (college, university, trade school, vocational school). Competitor must be maintaining a minimum of six (6) credit hours a semester.

SENIOR/MASTER (Ages 35 + years) - Beginner/Novice/Intermediate/Advanced

Divisions: Kobudo (long & short divisions for advanced) Kata, Kumite (light & heavy), Mandatory Kata (advanced senior athletes may also compete in this additional event)

Ages: 35-44, 45-54, 55+ (Competition age is age as of JULY 1, 2022, age groups may be combined) Senior/Master Competitors have the option to compete in the Adult Group (ages 18-34 yrs.), but must remain in that group for ALL events. If Senior/Master chooses to compete in the Adult Group (ages 18-34 yrs.), please check box on application.

Divisions: Kobudo, Kata & Kihon **Ages:** 5-15 years, 16+ years (Competition age is age as of July 1, 2022)

Heroes & Veterans Division: open to disabled veterans and first responders

Introducing Ultimate Rotational Team Kumite:

Will follow the rules of rotational team kumite. Open to all experience levels, ages 8 and up. Age groups will be: 8-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15-17, and 18 & up. If significant non-advanced competitors sign up we will consider splitting this division by experience level.

What is Ultimate Rotational Kumite? Participants who sign up for this event, will be randomly assigned to a team and a coach. It will be up to you and your fellow teammates, to come together and achieve victory over the other teams.

This is a separate event from rotational team kumite, so karateka can compete in both events.
