### Nihon Rotational Team Kumite

Category	Height	Length of Match	Points	Event of a tie
Children B	No height distinction	4-minutes Run time	No point limit; winning team with most points or advantage of 4 points	No draw; Officials must select winner

### Sanbon Rotational Team Kumite

Category	Weight	Length of Match	Points	Order of Determination - Winning Team
Mini Cadets Cadets Juniors Seniors Veterans	Open Weight	6-minutes Run time	No point limit; winning team with most points or advantage of 6 points	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Team with most points at the end of 6-minutes.</li> <li>2. Team with most Ippons wins.</li> <li>3. If no clear winner, Hantei is called and if a draw, 2-minutes Enchosen.</li> </ol>

### Sanbon Team Kumite

Category	Weight	Length of Match	Points	Order of Determination - Winning Team
Cadets	Open Weight	2-minutes	Winner = 3 Ippon or 6 Wazari, or athlete with more points at end of match.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Team with most wins.</li> <li>2. Team with most points (Ippon &amp; Wazari added together).</li> <li>3. Team with most Ippons.</li> <li>4. Extra Match, and if extra match results in a tie then 1-minute Enchosen.</li> </ol>
Juniors Seniors	Open Weight	3-minutes	<p>If match is tied, it will remain tied and there is no Hantei.</p> <p>Disqualification/Kiken = 3 Ippons to winner and "loser's" score will be that at time of opponent disqualification.</p>
