# Check-In

Coaches & Athlete check information can be found at the back of this packet. Only pre-registered coaches & athletes will receive credentials! Registration on-site is not guaranteed- please confirm your rosters via the district sheets. \*It is the head coach's responsibility to review the roster sent from the meet director to verify all their gymnasts and coaches are registered and their information is correct prior to arrival.

Credentials must be worn each day to enter the competition venue and obtain access onto the competition floor.

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# Food & Drink

Outside Food/Drink (coolers, take-out, etc.) are prohibited. Coaches and athletes are allowed to bring a water bottle (NO glass).

Coaches will have a hospitality area on the competition floor with snacks and lunch daily. Food may not be taken outside of the curtained area.

# Athletic Trainer

AAU Junior Olympic Games LOC provides trainers onsite. Please locate their booth by the head table for any sports medicine needs (ice, bandaids, injuries, etc.)

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## Awards

Flight awards will be given on the floor in the mornings for Tumbling, Trampoline and Double Mini. Athletes should report directly to the awards staging area, located behind the pipe and drape, following their Finals flights for podium awards. Single mini will not have flight awards unless there are multiple flights in the age group. They will report directly to awards staging after competing as there are no finals.

As per the AAU Trampoline and Tumbling Rulebook, age groups were limited to 20 athletes and will be broken by birthdate so athletes are competing with the athletes closest to their real age within the predefined age groups.

Special Awards will be given during our Parade of Champions Saturday morning.

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## Competition Cards

Competition cards can be pre filled or filled out onsite. They must be turned into the head table by 8:30am on Wednesday.

# Competition Format

## Trampoline/Tumbling/Double Mini

Every athlete will compete in Prelims in the mornings with the top ten in each age group advancing to Finals in the afternoon.

## Single Mini

Every athlete will compete one time for placements.

## Synchro Trampoline

All Synchro Pairs will compete on Saturday.

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# Coaches Meetings/Education

We will have coaches meetings thirty minutes before the competition each day.

We will have our Judges/Coaches roundtables for thirty minutes Wednesday-Friday immediately following the completion of competition. These will be a monitored time for Judges and Coaches to learn from each other based on the days competition. Coaches can ask general questions. This is not a time to critique competition scores but meant more as a time to be able to learn from each other.

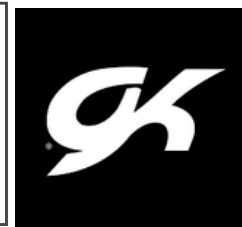

### **ATHLETES & COACHES**

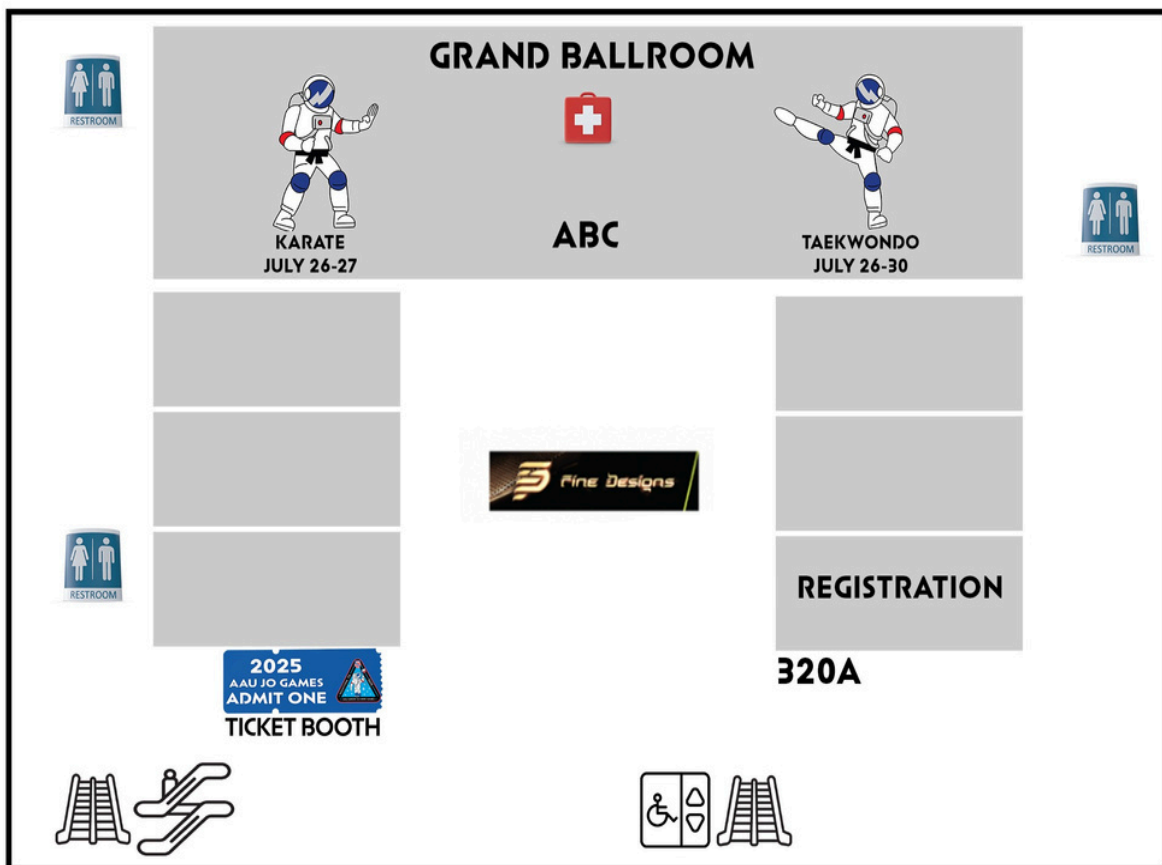

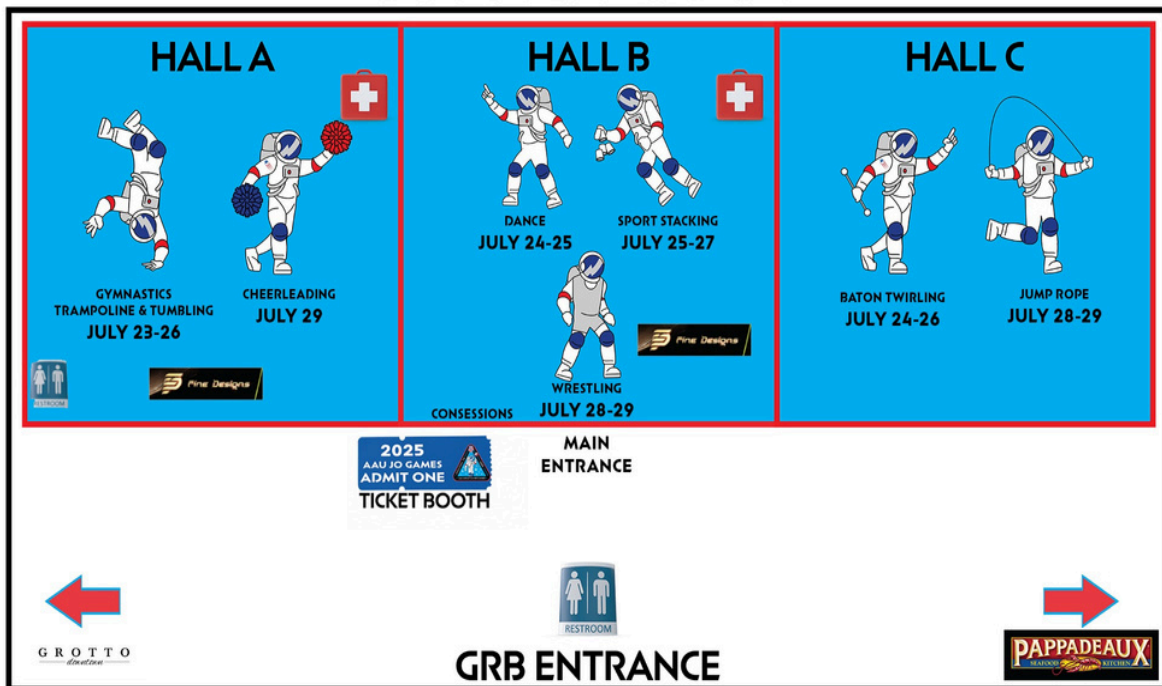
- ***Spectators can purchase wristbands at ticket booth locations per day for \$20. Event passes are available for \$50. Admission is free for kids ages 3 and under.***

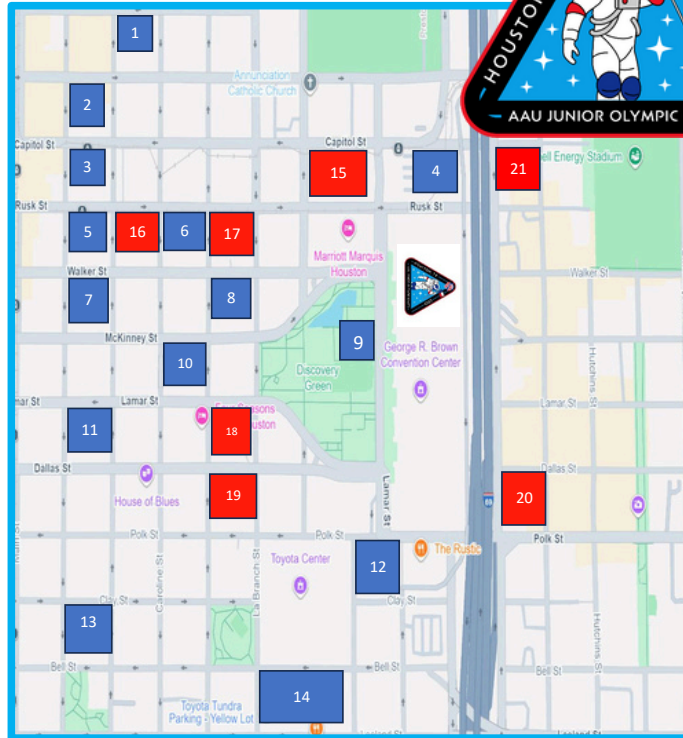

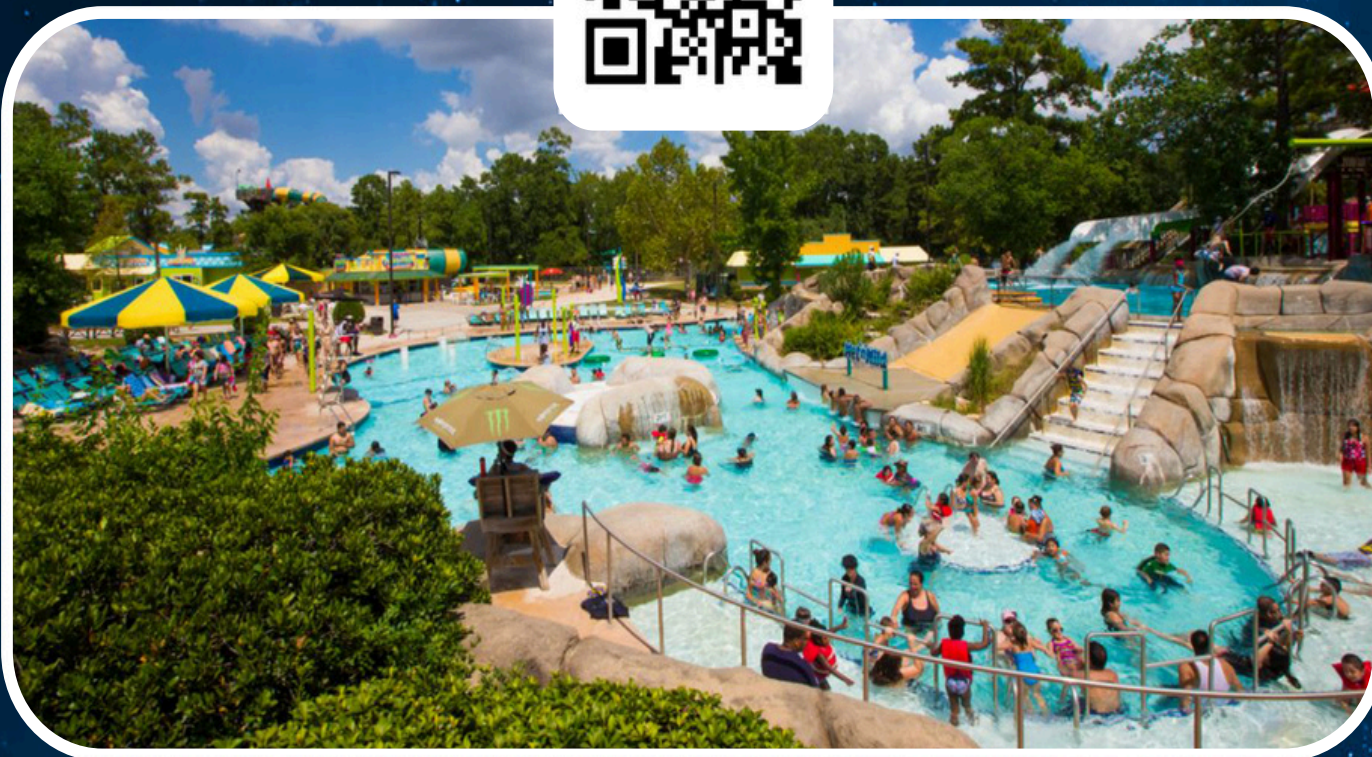
