Repetitive Spin Hook	<ul> <li>Single break format; One board per strike - See Board Sizes Below</li> <li>Allowed technique is spinning hook kick • 10 board competition</li> <li>Winner based on time required to break 10 boards</li> </ul>		
Repetitive Side Kick	<ul> <li>Single break format; One board per strike - See Board Sizes Below</li> <li>Allowed technique is side kick • 10 board competition</li> <li>Winner based on time required to break 10 boards</li> </ul>		
Repetitive Hand Technique (human hold)	<ul> <li>Single break format; One board per strike - See Board Sizes Below</li> <li>Allowed technique is hammer fist, palm, knife or fist (punch)</li> <li>10 board competition</li> <li>Winner based on time required to break 10 boards</li> </ul>
