Following lunch, we will practice hands-on scenarios, working both the center and corner judge positions.

The day will end between 3 and 4 depending on the number of officials and athletes.

- 1. All officials' clinics must be done at the local level on a yearly basis.
- 2. All currently certified referees must attend a local refresher clinic to keep their active status and to qualify to work at any of the current years' local or national events.
- 3. All referees must have current AAU membership. Apply for membership at www.aausports.org.
- 4. All referees will be expected to dress in the proper attire when attending the District Qualifier. This currently is black slacks and an official's polo.
