## NEW AAU CLUB LEVELS TO LAUNCH IN 2025

The AAU has made it a priority to protect and preserve our ability to offer benefits to all AAU members. This administration and the AAU Board of Directors heard AAU leaders' concerns and, therefore, voted to change the structure of the AAU Club Levels.

The new structure is simple and will include a "Standard Club" with three levels: A, B, and C., and a "Subordinate (non-profit) Tier Club," with three levels, known as Club Tier 1, 2 and 3.


The Standard Club Level A and B (formerly known as Club Level 1 and Club Level 2 respectively) will offer the same benefits, at the same fees. The only change has been the name. The new Club Level C was created to accommodate AAU Leadership's request for event directors to host single-sport events without geographical boundaries (and will be no voting privileges).

The new non-profit, Subordinate Clubs will be structured as Tier 1, Tier 2 and Tier 3. Tier 1 is for existing and new clubs with more than 100 registered members. Tier 2 is for other organizations who wish to partner with AAU. Tier 3 is a single-sport, event operator club with no geographical boundaries. Also, for Tier 2 and 3, there are no voting privileges as well as there will be changes to the application process and fees.




For many years AAU leadership has strived to improve and protect the Union. The new club levels will be the first step in offering the ability to conduct events with partners in multiple jurisdictions and venues throughout the United States.

| <b>Club Tier 2</b>  | <b>National Organizations.</b> For other national sports organizations similar to AAU in scope looking for partnership opportunities; will also receive benefit of not-for-profit subordinate status. <b>No voting privileges.</b> |
| <b>Club Tier 3</b>  | <b>Large Event Operators.</b> For event operators to host multiple events with no geographical boundaries; will also receive benefit of not-for-profit subordinate status. <b>No voting privileges.</b>                            |
