



NEW AAU CLUB LEVELS TO LAUNCH IN 2025

The AAU has made it a priority to protect and preserve our ability to offer benefits to all AAU members. This administration and the AAU Board of Directors heard AAU leaders' concerns and, therefore, voted to change the structure of the AAU Club Levels.

The new structure is simple and will include a "Standard Club" with three levels: A. B. and C., and a "Subordinate (non-profit) Tier Club," with three levels, known as Club Tier 1, 2 and 3.

The Standard Club Level A and B (formerly known as Club Level 1 and Club Level 2 respectively) will offer the same benefits, at the same fees.





For many years AAU leadership has strived to improve and protect the Union. The new club levels will be the first step in offering the ability to conduct events with partners in multiple jurisdictions and venues throughout the United States.

Standard ('REGULAR') Clubs	
Club Level A	Same benefits and requirements of our current Club Level 1.
Club Level B	Same benefits and requirements of current Club Level 2.
Club Level C	This level is for event operators to host multiple events without geographical boundaries; new exciting and enticing new benefits. No voting privileges.

Subordinate ('Non-Profit) Tier Clubs		
Club Tier 1	new	Super Clubs. Similar to current Club Level 3. For clubs that will register a minimum of 100 members and receive benefit of being a not-for-profit subordinate of the AAU.
Club Tier 2	new	National Organizations. For other national sports organizations similar to AAU in scope looking for partnership opportunities; will also receive benefit of not-for-profit subordinate status. No voting privileges .
Club Tier 3	new	Large Event Operators. For event operators to host multiple events with no geographical boundaries; will also receive benefit of not-for-profit subordinate status. No voting privileges .
