back to their seats immediately following
their teams performance.**

No outside food or drinks are allowed.



When you arrive to Houston, you will need to complete your on site registration. Athletes and coaches need to be prepared to provide their name and AAU membership #. They will then receive their credentials needed for competition. Coaches listed on the roster and verified for Junior Olympics in Reg Champ can check their whole team in with no problem. However, all coaches must check themselves in. If parents are checking their own child in- they just need to be prepared to provide their AAU #. There are multiple on site registration check in times that would work for cheerleading. Teams are just required to check in at least one day prior to competition. See picture attached.

We recommend that all participants check-in onsite at least one day prior to their competition. Please see Entry Packet for detailed information on check-in date. A coach or team representative can check-in the athlete. At Check-In, participants will receive a credential or wristband (depending on the sport) to gain admittance into the competition venues. Credentials and wristbands are non-transferable.

Check-In for the following sports ONLY:

Baton Twirling*, Cheerleading, Dance, Fencing, Gymnastics, Jump Rope*, Karate*, Sport Stacking, Trampoline & Tumbling, Taekwondo* and Wrestling*

*Baton Twirling, Jump Rope, Karate, Taekwondo and Wrestling participants must also check-in or weigh-in with the Sport Committee. Please refer to the sport entry packet for information and times.

Music

Warm Ups

Please report to the warm up area 10 min prior to your first mat time.

Everyone entering the warm-up room, and not in uniform, must be wearing a coaches credential.

Only coaches and athletes of the competing TEAM may enter the warm-up area

All teams will receive 5 minutes per floor.

Warm-up Floors:

- *12 by 42 Foam Floor**
- *12 by 60 Spring Tumble Strip**
- *42 by 54 Foam Floor with audio**



One coach per program will need to plan to check in at the head table near the judges riser in Hall A the day of the event.

Scoring

Scoresheets will be sent to the email account connected with your registration approximately 15 minutes after each performance. If you have any scoring questions, please report to the head table and a scoring representative will be contacted to assist you. Results will be emailed at the conclusion of the event.

Awards

Awards Ceremonies and Team Placements will take place on the competition floor.

All Athletes will receive a T-shirt, participation certificate, and medal. All teams will receive a banner.

First Place Division Champions will receive "Champion" jackets. Jacket pick up will take place behind the main competition floor following the awards ceremony.

Championship Rings will be awarded to Level and Grand Champions.
