AWARDS: AAU Junior Olympic Games medals will be awarded to the members of the top three (3) teams.

- **TEAM CHECK-IN:** A team representative must check-in the team at the **lowa Events Center on July 24 between 8:00 am and 4:00 pm.** The lowa Events Center is located at 730 3rd Street, Des Moines, IA 50309. At check-in, athlete credentials and bench personnel wristbands will be distributed. The appropriate credential or wristband will be needed prior to gaining admittance into the competition venues. *There is a replacement fee for lost credentials or wristbands.* Parking fees do apply for the lots around the lowa Events Center. - **COACHES MEETING:** A coaches meeting will take place on July 24. The location and time of the meeting will be announced after the entry deadline.
- CELEBRATION OF
