Entries must be completed online by **Wednesday, July 24, 2024**. Visa, MasterCard, American Express or Discover is accepted. You will need to have your AAU membership at the time of registering. After registering online, you will receive an email confirming your entry and acceptance of payment. Coaches and parents can enter for free; however, all attendees must have a valid AAU membership. **You must have your membership completed in advance.**

The Local Organizing Committee and the AAU have spent many hours planning and preparing for this AAU Event. In order to make it a great success, we are asking for your cooperation. It is the responsibility of the parent, coach, instructor, and athlete to ensure that the application is in on time and complete in every detail.

**AAU MEMBERSHIP:**

**All athletes and coaches must be current members of the AAU.** AAU membership is \$20.00 per youth athlete, \$30.00 per adult athlete and \$75.00 per coach (non-athlete 2 year membership). The cost of membership is in addition to the entry fee. To become a member, register on-line at [www.aasports.org](http://www.aasports.org).

**BE PREPARED and register your coaches early! You can no longer register for non-athlete (coach) membership onsite at the event. New this year, background screens are conducted for all non-athletes and adult athletes. Membership is no longer instant.**

**ELIGIBILITY:**

The athlete must be an AAU member in good standing. Each athlete can participate in any/all 3 weapons as long as such events are not happening at the same time. Athletes can participate in their age group and/or the age group above (Except Y14, they can also compete in JUNIOR if they choose to).

**AGE DIVISIONS:**

6 & Under/Y-6 (2017-2018), 8 & Under/Y-8(2015-2016), 10 & Under/Y-10 (2013-2014), 12 & Under/Y-12 (2011-2012), 14 & Under/Y14(2009-2010), Cadet (2007-2008), Junior (2004-2006), Men/Female/Mixed Categories.

**ENTRY FEE:**

\$55.00 tournament fee + \$40 per event  
Registered AAU coaches/parents, please pick up your coaches badge to be allowed to strip coach (No more than 2 coaches/parents can be on the strip coaching at the same time).  
**All entry fees are non-refundable.**

**RULES:**

Competition will be played by FLA and adopted AAU Rules.

**HOUSING:**

**ONSITE CHECK-IN:** All registered participants must check-in at the Greensboro Coliseum Complex – 1921 W. Gate City Boulevard, Greensboro, NC 27403 to receive their athlete credential or coach wristband. The appropriate credential or wristband will be needed prior to gaining admittance into the competition venues. If that credential or wristband is lost or stolen there will be a replacement fee. All participants must check-in the day prior to the competition. **AWARDS:** Awards from 1<sup>st</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> place will be handed out in each event.

You must have the appropriate wristband or credential.

Spectators can purchase tickets onsite at the venues. Daily passes are \$20.00 (3 & under free) and includes admission to all competition venues on the designated day only.
