

1. ATHLETES & COACHES CHECK IN FOR PARADE Coaches check-in 6pm | Athletes check in 6:30pm All athletes and coaches check in at the check in table for the parade. Coaches are S TRONGLY encouraged to attend. Coaches will be responsible for their athletes.

2. ATHLETES LINE UP AT BEACH

Athletes will then preceed to the beach and line up by district. On the beach we will have a handstand contest. Coaches are asked to stay with their athletes at all times.



3. PARENTS LINE THE BOARDWALK

Parents will line the boardwalk where they can observe the handstand contest. You will then have a front row seat to the parade and cheer on your favorite district! Parents will follow the conclusion of the parade to the bandshell where we will continue celebrating our athletes!

4. BANDSHELL

The parade will end at the bandshell where we will contine the celebration! We will have a live DJ, do the flash mob together, and end the night with fireworks! Athletes will stay with their team and district for the event in the section designated for athletes only.



5. DISMISSAL

Athletes will stay with their team/district until the completion of the fireworks. At the end of the evening, we will dismiss by district to their designated gate.



Located in the concourse at the Ocean Center outside the Event Center.

Cash and credit cards accepted (*card transaction fees apply) *Registered athletes receive complimentary entrance to all sessions with their credentials.

FOOD & DRINK

Outside Food/Drink (coolers, take-out, etc.) are prohibited. Concessions will be available for purchase. Gymnasts are allowed to bring a small snack & water bottle (NO glass). *Food purchased at Ocean Center may not be taken to Peabody Auditorium and viseversa.



GYMNAST CHECK-IN

Gymnasts may check in anytime before their designated session (located in the meeting rooms 103/104 downstairs of the Ocean Center, directly inside the Ocean Center, directly inside the entrance near the crosswalk outside the Peabody Auditorium). Gymnasts must wear these credentials to gain entrance into the competition venue. Gymnasts wishing to return to another time to cheer on their teammates will need these credentials to gain free entrance. Only pre-registered gymnasts will receive credentials.

Gymnasts will also receive their gymnast gift at gymnast check-in.

*It is the head coach's responsibility to review the roster sent from the meet director to verify all their gymnasts and coaches are registered and their information is correct prior to arrival.

ATHLETIC TRAINER



With the focus of athlete safety, health and well-being at the forefront of what we do, AAU Gymnastics has partnered with Premier Sports Medicine to provide industry leading athletic trainers during this weekends competition.

JUDGES

Our judges for this event are all certified members of the National Association of Gymnastics Judges, represented from more than 15 states and come at the recommendation of their district delegation. These officials spend countless hours annually fulfilling required continuing education credits, hold memberships in many different organizations (USAG, NCAA, etc.) and have devoted their weekends to serving the sport of gymnastics. Please be respectful to not talk to the judges or negatively discuss scores or judgments with your neighbors or your athletes. Direct all scoring questions to your coaches.





AAU Gymnastics promotes an inclusive, rewarding & positive competitive experience for everyone. Please support all the athletes by staying in the competition seating area until the final athlete of the session competes. You can also help maintain our vision of a supportive sports community by refraining from making judgemental comments or inappropriate remarks about any athlete, coach, judge, etc. We encourage you and your gymnasts to cheer for all the gymnasts from your team and opposing teams during both competition and awards. AWARDS

The awards area is located in the Peabody Auditorium (across Auditorium Blvd. directly across the entrance of the Ocean Center).

Hosting our awards ceremony in this auditorium is sure to finish the event in an exciting and comfortable way, with ample seating, fantastic lighting and unbeatable ambiance & sound. We ask for your cooperation with ensuring your gymnasts report directly to the award area after their session in an effort to keep the event running efficiently as all three gyms will be sharing this one stage.

*Session competition times were staggered to prevent overlapping awards ceremonies, but please be patient as we anticipate wait times.



Gymnasts are subdivided into awards group of 14 or fewer athletes based on their birthdate. AAU National Championship Medals will be awarded to the top 50% + 1 on each individual event and 100% in the all-around. There are no club team awards.

AAU All-American plaques are presented to the highest all-around gymnast per session, per level, regardless of age.



NATIONAL TEAM

Each session, gymnasts with the top 3 scores on each individual event, per level, regardless of age group will be recognized as the National Team Members at the conclusion of each awards ceremony, receiving an AAU National Team Member Pin.



In addition to receiving a National Team Member pin, youth, female National Team Members in Levels: 1-7, Copper, Bronze, Silver, Gold & Platinum will also receive an **AAU Junior Olympic Qualifier Certificate** and be eligible to register for the AAU Junior Olympic Games!

Qualifying gymnasts should report to the AAU Junior Olympic Booth in the lobby of the Peabody Auditorium to learn more, register & secure your spot!

PARENTS will be responsible for paying the \$115 registration fee for their qualifying gymnast ON SITE to the AAU Junior Olympic Games. Please visit the JO Games Booth in the lobby of the Peabody Auditorium after your gymnast's awards ceremony.

JO GAMES REGISTRATION DEADLINE: SUNDAY, JUNE 23RD AT 2PM!

*Please confirm your gymnasts' club is intending to attend this event. *Additional coaches fees may apply. Inquire within your gym club. *Event open to all athletes under ONE set of Junior Olympic rules (modified level 8) without qualification. *Event applicable to youth, female athletes only this year.

REMINDERS

- Please arrive 30 minutes prior to your scheduled session to allow time for parking, navigating the competition venue, ticketing and gymnast check-in.
- This is an AAU licensed event: only pre-registered AAU gymnasts, coaches, staff and judges are allowed onto the competition floor. If you need your athlete, please contact your coach.
- Please be mindful not to use excessive glitter or makeup that leaves residue on equipment.
- Do not allow your children to throw balls in the spectator area as this poses a risk to the competitors.
- Flash photography or lights on cameras is prohibited for the safety of the gymnasts.
- Weapons are strictly prohibited *see venue website for more restricted items.
- Leave the professional photography to our vendor! Professional grade photography equipment is prohibited.
- Sideline coaching can be very distracting and dangerous to the gymnasts. Allow your coaches to do their jobs during the event. Sit back and enjoy watching your gymnast's hard work pay off this season!
- Beware of online scammers! AAU Gymnastics does not offer ticket pre-sales, live streaming or recordings of this event!
